

# How to Use the New Color Sticks

Great info from makeup artist Robert Jones!

Think of the new pencils in terms of parts to your looks:

color	ivory skin tone	beige skin	bronze skin	ebony skin
<b>taupe shimmer</b>	highlight	highlight	highlight	
<b>copper glaze</b>	accent	highlight	highlight	highlight
<b>violet dawn</b>	accent	accent		
<b>jade mist</b>	accent	accent	accent	accent

Now you can simply use them knowing which component of your eye look they are for example:

skintone	highlight	midtone	accent	eyeliner
ivory	<b>taupe shimmer</b>	hazelnut	<b>violet dawn</b>	<b>violet dawn</b>
ivory	white sand	rose mist	<b>copper glaze</b>	<b>copper glaze</b>
beige	<b>taupe shimmer</b>	hazelnut	vintage gold	bronze
beige	<b>copper glaze</b>	hazelnut	<b>jade mist</b>	<b>jade mist</b>
bronze	<b>taupe shimmer</b>	dbl espresso(pink)	cranberry ice	sable
bronze	<b>copper glaze</b>	cinnabar	<b>jade mist</b>	<b>jade mist</b>
ebony	<b>copper glaze</b>	cinnabar	current craze	charcoal
ebony	<b>copper glaze</b>	cinnabar	<b>jade mist</b>	<b>jade mist</b>

Simply apply the pencil then take your finger or a brush and blend it out!!! The great thing about these pencils is that they wear really well and are easy to use.

The lip pencils are great because they give you really long wear and you get liner and color in one!!! But feel free to use lip gloss on top of them, nothing makes your lips look fuller or sexier than glossy lips.
